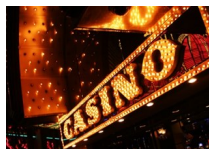

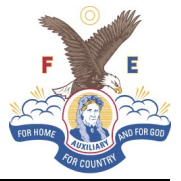

Spooky Halloween Crossword Puzzle

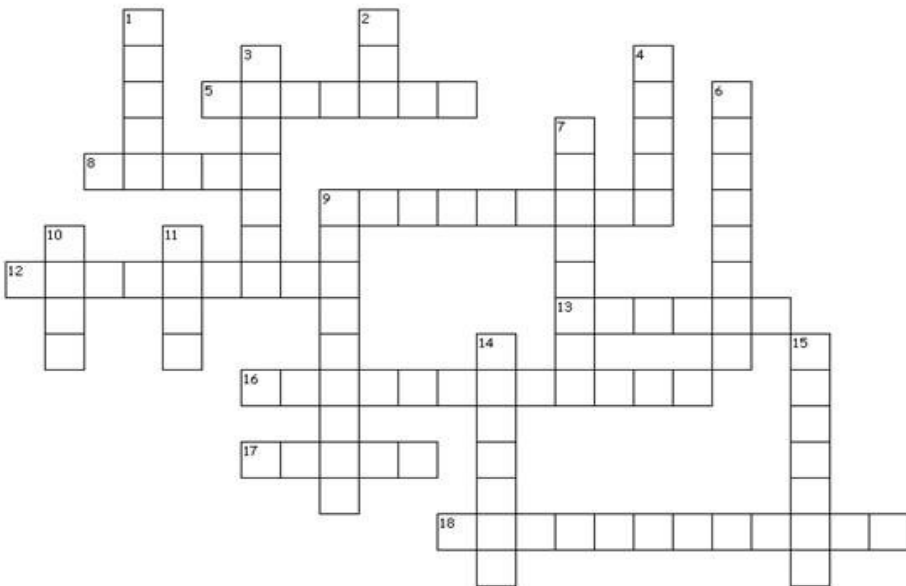
